A new thermal version, XRT Insulator™ will be launched in October in time for the winter months, designed to protect at temperatures $\geq -30^{\circ}\text{C}$ and finished in hi-visibility fluorescent orange.

Ideal for use as a general all-purpose glove for industries such as engineering, construction, general maintenance and transport, the new XRT™ range combines high comfort and flexibility with general protection excellent abrasion resistance, good grip and good looks.



Manufactured from synthetic leather (PU coating on nylon) on the palm, thumbs and fingertips of the glove and Lycra synthetic fibres on the back of the hand, the XRT™ range also has an elasticated wrist to keep the glove fitted and a sleeve to cover the wrist.

In addition to mechanical protection, Marigold Industrial Ltd also performed industry standard laboratory absorption tests on the new XRT™ range and on traditional leather gloves at the same time, to see how they performed compared to each other.

The results revealed that the XRT™ gloves outperformed traditional leather gloves, having much slower oil and water absorption performance.

Oil and then water droplets were placed on a swatch of the palm of XRT™ gloves and the leather gloves, and the absorption levels measured after 10 seconds and 30 seconds.

"The new XRT™ range provides workers who need general all purpose gloves with a completely new offering and a perfect alternative to traditional leather gloves.
